

## **Public Mural Call for Art**

Highland Main Street, in conjunction with Highland Redevelopment Commission and Highland Community Foundation, is looking for an artist to complete a public outdoor mural in downtown Highland this summer. The Mural will help launch a Sculpture and Art Walk throughout downtown Highland. The selected artist will receive a \$500 stipend, which has been secured through a Spring Into Summer grant from the Legacy Foundation.

Interested artists are invited to submit a sketch of their proposed mural design, including proposed dimensions, along with a current bio, to [lryskamp@highland.in.gov](mailto:lryskamp@highland.in.gov). Please use Mural Project in the subject line of your email. There is no cost to apply. Artists may submit multiple proposals. Art group/collaborative work is welcome. There is no theme for the mural, however only family friendly concepts will be considered. Preferential review will be given to Highland residents, followed by Lake County residents.

The mural location is at 2821 Jewett, and is a cinderblock building currently painted grey. Uninterrupted wall dimensions are 32'L x 14'W. There is additionally a large garage door and an access door, for a total façade size of 50.5'L x 14'W. Artists may utilize the entire façade, including the doors, if desired. Proposals should include dimensions, and detail if the doors will be incorporated.

The Redevelopment Commission will reimburse artists up to \$400 for supplies. The artist/team chosen will receive a \$500 stipend. Transportation, excess supplies, conceptual design, and artist work, etc., are all part of this stipend. No additional monies will be given beyond the \$500 stipend.

Deadline to apply: Monday August 15, 2016

Notifications: Tuesday August 23, 2016

All work must be completed prior to September 30, 2016.
