

## **Public Mural Call for Art**

Highland Main Street, in conjunction with Highland Redevelopment Commission is looking for an artist to complete a public outdoor mural in downtown Highland this spring. The Mural will help continue the Sculpture and Art Walk throughout downtown Highland. The selected artist will receive a \$500 stipend.

Interested artists are invited to submit a sketch of their proposed mural design, in a .jpeg format and including proposed dimensions, along with a current bio, to [lryskamp@highland.in.gov](mailto:lryskamp@highland.in.gov). Please use Mural Project in the subject line of your email. There is no cost to apply. Artists may submit multiple proposals. Art group/collaborative work is welcome. There is no theme to the mural, and only family friendly concepts will be considered. There is an existing mural located on the south elevation of the building adjacent to this site.

Preferential review will be given to Highland residents, followed by Lake County residents.

The mural location is at 2819 Jewett (east elevation of Miles Books), and is a cinderblock building currently painted terracotta. The total façade size is approximately 78' Wide x 15'4" High. Artists may utilize the entire façade.

The Redevelopment Commission will reimburse artists up to \$700 for supplies and provide a \$500 stipend. Transportation, excess supplies, conceptual design, and artist work, etc., are all part of this stipend. No additional monies will be given beyond the \$500 stipend.

All work must be completed by June 3, 2017.
