

BRANCH COLLECTION PROGRAM

The Town of Highland provides branch collection and disposal services as a part of its solid waste management program.

WHEN ...

The program begins in early spring and concludes the second week of October when leaf collection begins. There is no need to call for a collection. Please refer to the map for your scheduled pick-up day.

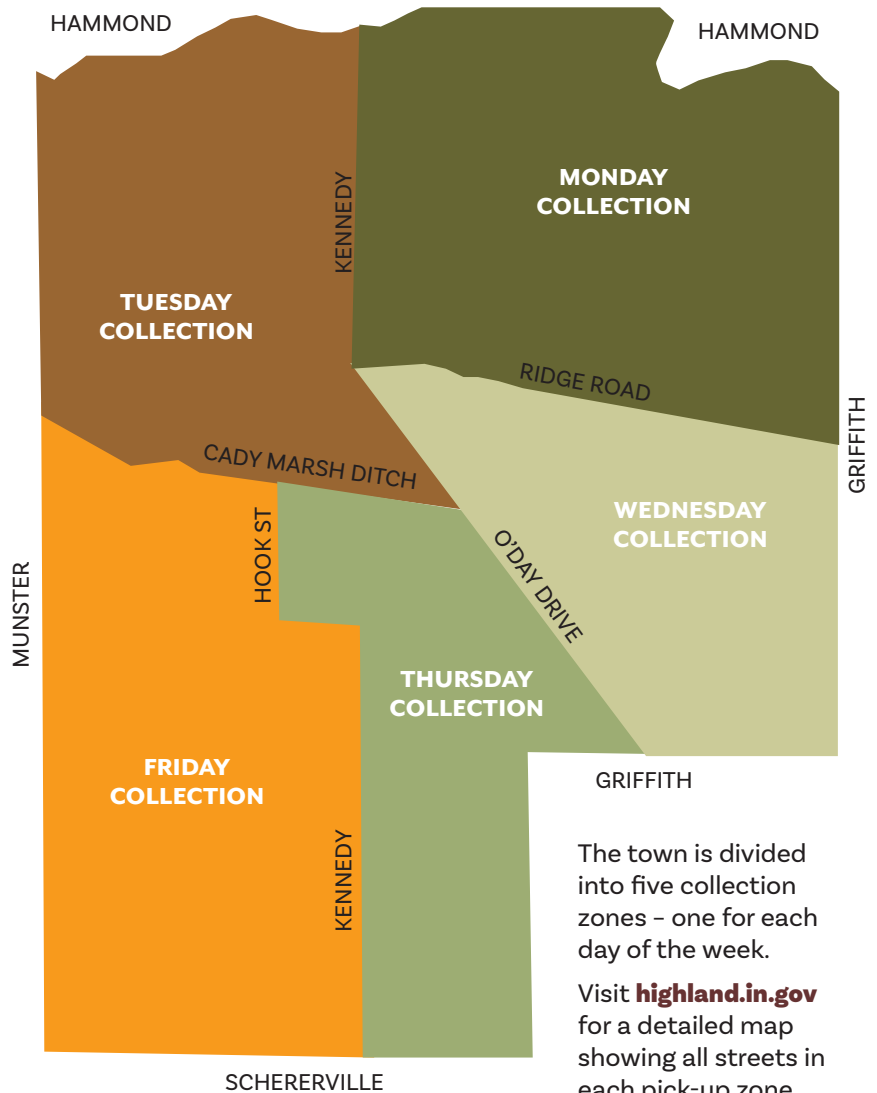
“Following severe storms, crews may be delayed for one or two days,” Highland Public Works Director John Bach said. “However, please know we will continue to follow the map until the crews catch up with the demand.”

WHERE ...

Branches must be placed in the front of the home (no alley pick-ups) prior to the scheduled day for collection. Small amounts of twigs and branches that are cut into small, manageable pieces can be disposed in your trash can. Larger amounts of branches can be placed in piles in front of your home that are a size that can be handled by one person.



DAILY BRANCH PICKUP ZONES



The town is divided into five collection zones - one for each day of the week.

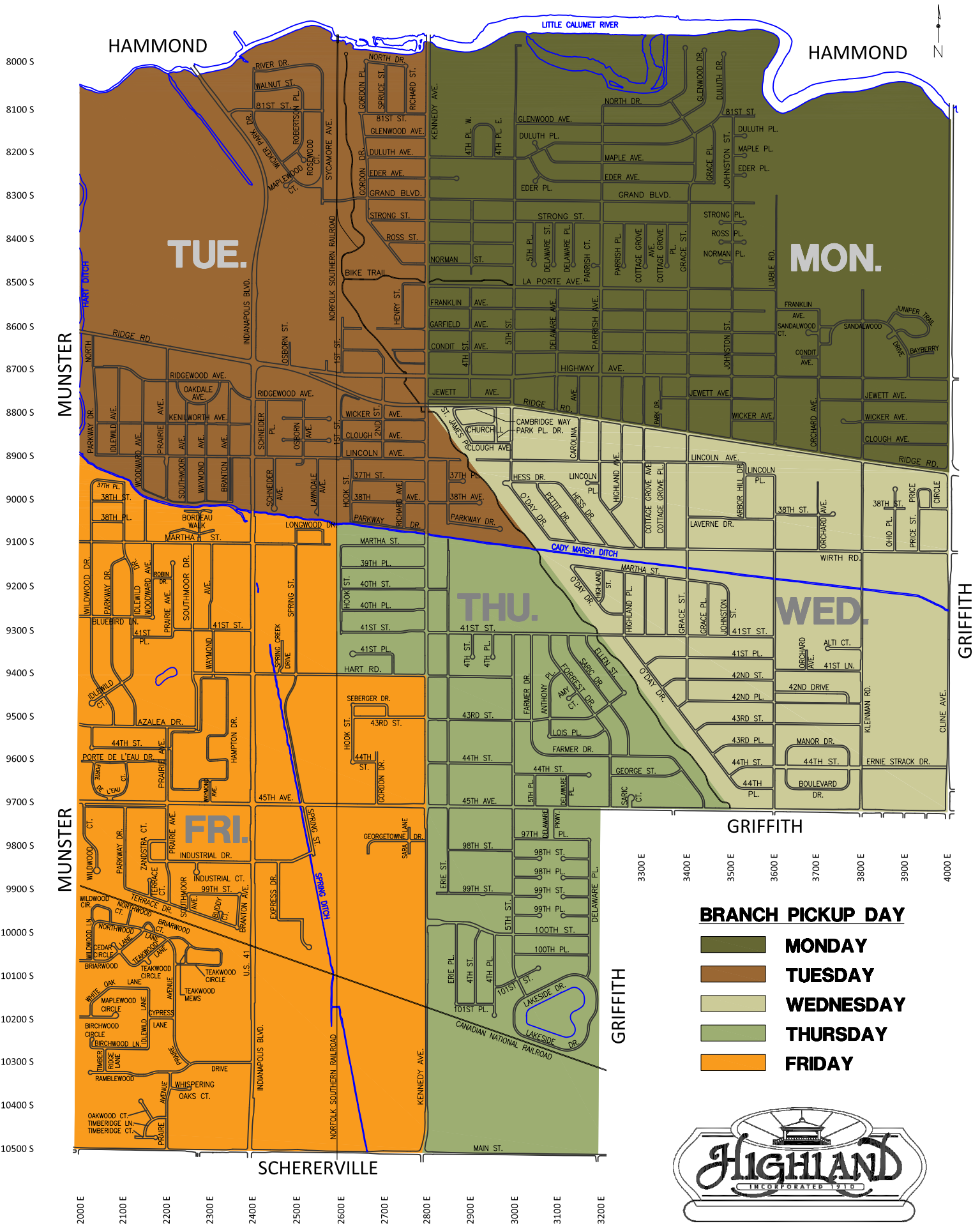

LARGE TREES, STUMPS & BUSHES ...

The Town does not provide branch collection for large trees that have been cut down. Residents that engage a tree service for tree trimming or tree removal must have the contractor dispose of branches and stumps.

Large stumps or bushes that have been removed with the root system are collected on Fridays. Residents needing this service should call Public Works at (219) 972-5083.
