

**TRAFFIC SAFETY MEETING**  
**May 5, 2020**

The Traffic Safety Commission convened as an electronic meeting, pursuant to Governor Holcomb's Executive Orders 20-04,20-09 and reinstated by Order 20-18, allowing such meetings, pursuant to IC 5-14-1.5-3.6 for the duration of the emergency. Chief Hojnicky called the meeting to order at 8:10 A.M.

The parking complaint at Highway Ave and Delaware Street was addressed Public Works Director John Bach stating the corner/curb area will be repainted. Commander Banasiak will seek input from the homeowner as to exactly what the complaint entails.

A question was raised as to whether a Pedestrian Crossing could be placed on the ground at the 45<sup>th</sup> Street/ Bike Trail along with the Hawk Signal. On a motion by Public Works Director John Bach and a second by Commissioner Jurczak and with a single roll call vote the Commission voted that no Pedestrian Crossing signage would be placed on the ground as the outer lanes would not have a clear visual and Robyn Pappenheim of DVG Team stated it would cause conflicting traffic control devices.

A resident's safety concern/request for a safety guard rail, at the intersection of Eder Street/Duluth St had much discussion resulting with a motion by Commander Banasiak and Public Works Director John Bach second and the single roll call vote of the Commission, denying the request. The Chief will draft a response with recommendations to the homeowner to help alleviate their concerns, to follow the Parkway Ordinance and speak with the Building Commissioner.
