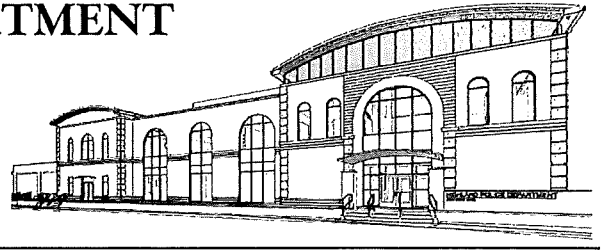

An anonymous resident brought in Boss Man Tacos for all staff.

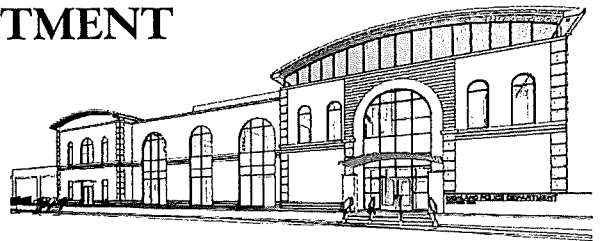
