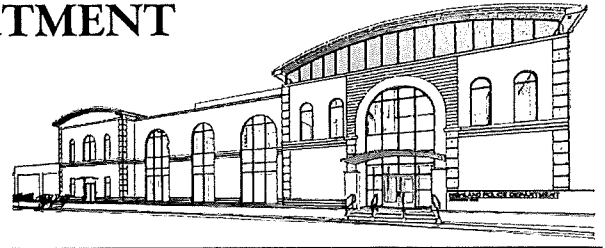

Officer Vanni was commended by a subject involved in her first accident stating he was wonderful and a great representative of an Officer.

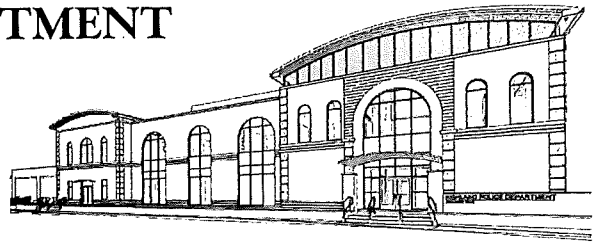
