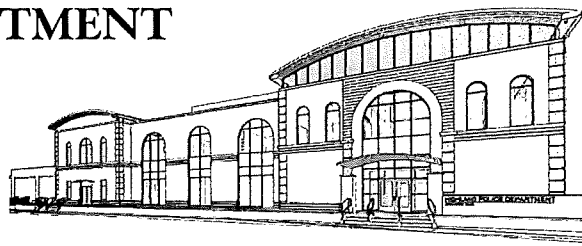

HIGHLAND POLICE COMMISSION MEETING

Sept 12, 2019

The Highland Police Commission met in regular session at the Public Safety Building. Commissioner Jurczak called the meeting to order at 7:00 P.M., followed by the Pledge of Allegiance.

Roll Call: Commissioners Jurczak, Krooswyk and Danko were present as well as Chief Hojnicky, Attorney Jared Tauber and Councilman Herak. Absent with prior notice were Commissioners Slagle and Moes.

Minutes of the Aug 8, 2019 meeting were approved.
Approval was given to forward claims to the Town Council for payment.

Training

On a motion by Commissioner Krooswyk and seconded by Commissioner Danko the Commission on a viva voce vote approved the following training:

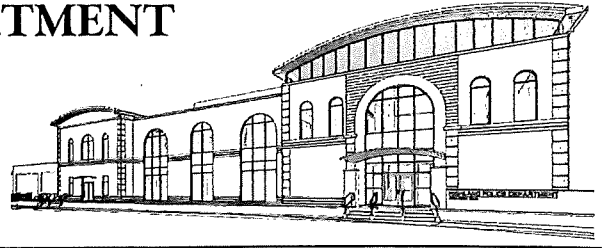
With no further business, the meeting adjourned at 7:20 P.M. as recorded by Chief Hojnicky.
