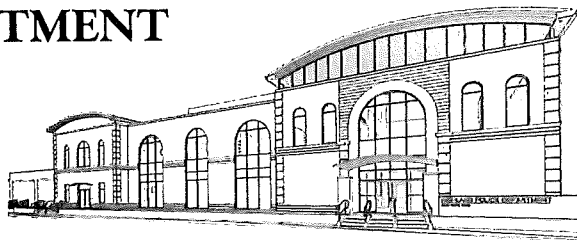

Dana Cochran wanted to share that Officer Perez was wonderful in assisting her with her case.

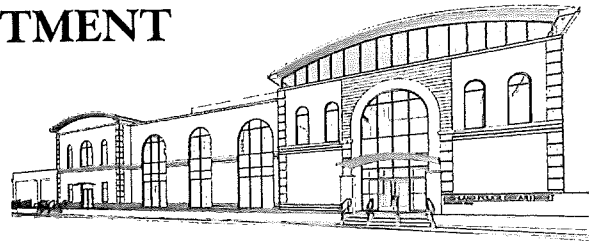
