9.45.010 Curfew

- (A) It is a curfew violation for a child 15,16, or 17 years of age to be in a public place:
- (1) Between 12:00AM and 5:00AM on Saturday or Sunday;
- (2) After 10:30PM on Sunday, Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, or Thursday; or
- (3) Before 5:00AM on Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday, or Friday.
- (B) It is a curfew violation for a child less than 15 years of age to be in a public place after 10:00PM or before 5:30AM on
- any day.

 (c) <u>Defenses:</u> A law enforcement officer may not detain a child or take a child into custody based on a violation of this

section unless a law enforcement officer, after making a reasonable determination and considering the facts and

surrounding circumstances, reasonably believes that:

- (1) The child has violated this section, and
- (2) There is no legal defense to the violation.
