A residents request for a four-way stop sign at Martha St and Spring St/Longwood Drive was discussed. The location currently has a two-way stop sign. It was determined there is not a large flow of traffic for this intersection, as Martha and Longwood is a dead-end street, and with no accident history relating to the intersection a four-way stop is not warranted.

A complaint was taken from a resident on Spring Street regarding the "semi" or large trucks that are driving on Spring Street coming off Indianapolis Blvd. Signage is posted for No Trucks and this will be monitored.

Patrol Commander Banasiak inquired about the possibility of southbound Kennedy at 45th Street and southbound Kennedy at Main Street having a 5th signal head with a continuous arrow turn. Public Works Director Mark Knesek stated he would check into this.
