A discussion was had by those present regarding the residential parking issues in the areas of the 9200 block of Waymond Ave., by vehicles from the Hampton Apartments.

A motion was made by Councilman Tom Black and seconded by Police Commissioner Steve Jurczak to have Town Ordinance No. 1619 amended to the following: Under Chapter 10.35 Parking Schedules-Section 10.35.100 Schedule IX- Parking without special permit display prohibited, amending to the following:

From 2116/2117 Azalea Drive east to Prairie Ave on the south side of the street, extending West to 2000/2001 Azalea and east to Southmoor on the north side of the street.

From 2116/2117 44<sup>th</sup> east to Prairie Ave on both the north and south side of the street extending West to 2012/2017 44<sup>th</sup>.

From 9321 Southmoor Drive on the east side of the street to Hart Road extending north to 9201/9204 Southmoor Drive.

From 9320/9321 Waymond Ave on both the east and west sides of the street to Hart Road, extending north to 9201/9202 Waymond Ave.

These amendments will be forwarded to the Town Council for consideration/codification.
