Some Discussion was had regarding the Traffic Safety for the new Bridge to Martha, Public Works Director Mark Knesek advised the construction is still ongoing and is currently closed off to traffic of any kind with several matters still not addressed.

Discussion was had from residents of the Brantwood neighborhood in regards to the speed bump installation. Comments were made from both sides, those for them and those against them. Currently, two of our speed signs are in place on Prairie Ave gathering the "before" data. Very shortly, the speed bumps will then be installed and then the speed signs will be able to gather the "after" data. All of this data will be used in order to set the requirement standard for future speed sign requests in Highland.
